Founder of Terry Neese Personnel Services, and an inductee into the National and Oklahoma Women's Hall of Fames, Dr. Terry Neese is a past national president of the National Association of Women Business Owners (NAWBO), the largest women's association of its kind. She is the Chief Executive Officer of the Institute for Economic Empowerment of Women (IEEW).

A successful businesswoman, Terry made history in 1990 when she became the first woman nominated by a major political party for the seat of Lt. Governor of Oklahoma. She was recognized by Fortune magazine as one of the "Power 30" – the most influential small business-persons in Washington, DC.

Terry is recognized as a national expert on economic issues that affect women and families. Her articles have been published in the Chicago Sun-Times, Entrepreneurial Women Magazine, Fort Worth Star-Telegram, the Journal Record, the Oklahoman, Washington Examiner, and the Washington Times.
